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
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## Introduction

*Ecce ego facio nova* – a composition for four-part mixed choir and organ – was written on the occasion of the fifth (biennial) Hinsz Composition Competition in the Hanseatic city of Kampen, The Netherlands. For their composition, the competitors had to make use of the phrase 'Behold, I will do a new thing' (Isaiah 43 : 19). They could choose whichever Bible language, I chose the Latin translation from the Vulgate.

The musical outset of *Ecce ego facio nova* lies in Paris. During a long weekend over there, my niece Eline – to whom I dedicated the piece, her boyfriend, my wife and I walked along the Seine, and all of a sudden, a tiny, two-bar fragment came to my mind:



This fragment – which wouldn't go out of my head – would become the main theme of *Ecce*.

The theme unfolds word for word, voice for voice. The mass begins, in a rather Gregorian manner. When the women join, the whole becomes four-part; the organ joins more strongly and merges into the fabric. After this, various things happen: modulations, two-part sections, re-entry of Gregorianism. Finally, all elements build up to a *fortissimo* climax.

*Ecce ego facio nova* won the Hinsz award.

## About Halbe de Jong



Halbe de Jong (1970) grew up in a music-minded family. He received his first organ lessons from his mother. Later teachers were (amongst others) Erwin Wiersinga (piano) and Piet Wiersma (organ). After secondary school, Halbe studied Dutch Language and Literature at the University of Groningen. Halbe combined the last years of his study with several state exams Music. After that, he studied Music Theory, at the academies of music in Groningen and The Hague.

Halbe's current musical activities fall into chorus conducting, piano- and organ playing (performing and accompanying), orchestrating and composing. Furthermore, Halbe is editor of the annual *Snoeks*-magazine.

In 2010, Halbe wrote the five-part *Drenthe Mass*, scored for four-part mixed choir, organ and strings (text by Willem Jan van der Veen). The occasion was the 65-th anniversary of his Drenthe choir Laudate Vocatis. This mass will appear in record next year, along with *Ecce ego facio nova* and other choir-compositions.
